

CANTALK PROCEDURE

- Access CanTalk by dialing 1-800-240-5778.
 - a. Wait for Language Line operator to answer
- 2. The CanTalk operator will **require the following information**:
 - a. Client Identification Number: 8361
 - b. Organization Name: Red Deer City Victim Services Unit
 - c. Name: Your First & Last Name
 - d. State the Language you are requesting.
- 3. When the interpreter is connected, note the interpreter's name for call back purposes if need be.
- 4. Brief the interpreter as to what you require. Be as specific and brief as possible. "I'm with the Red Deer City Victim Services Unit. This person was assaulted two days ago, and I'm calling to see how they are doing."
- 5. Once the interpreter has been briefed, advise them to hold while you make contact with the victim
- 6. Push the **CONFERENCE (CONF)** button on your phone to get a dial tone.
- 7. Call the victim by dialing 9 first. When they answer, push the **CONFERENCE (CONF)** button again, to bring the interpreter into the conversation.
- 8. Stay on the line throughout the duration of the conversation. It is your responsibility to direct the conversation.
- 9. After the call is completed, you may request for the interpreter to stay on the line for further Debriefing (this will require the victim to hang up first), or simply hang up to complete the interpretation.

Please report any problems or concerns with the interpreter to a staff member immediately.
